## Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education Priorities

- SAMHSA'S Recovery Community Services Program- Statewide Networks (RCSP-SN)- a current grant program that further enhances the presence of Recovery Community Organizations as key partners in treatment, recovery, and affiliated health systems.
- SAMHSA'S Treatment Capacity Enhancement Peer-to-Peer (TCE Peer-to-Peer) is a current grant program that expands service capacity through the provision of peer recovery support services. A primary program objective is to help individuals achieve and maintain recovery and improve the overall quality of life for those being served.
- SAMHSA'S Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment (SABT) Block Grant- We urge you to make an adjustment that requires a 10% set aside of grant funds to support the provision of recovery support services by recovery community organizations.

## Commerce, Justice, and Science

• Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA), Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Program (COAP) Training and Technical Assistance (TTA) Program- a grant program that supports COAP grantees in incorporating peer recovery support as a component of effective programs. This program established a national training and technical assistance center to support peer recovery support partnerships in the criminal justice and child welfare systems.

Please make these vital programs among your funding priorities in FY 2018. Your support will ensure continuation of the critical funds needed to support substance use disorder treatment and recovery support in [insert\_state].
